

MINUTES OF THE 2012 BROOKTONDALE CONTRACT PUBLIC HEARING

October 16, 2012

The Danby Fire District Brooktondale Contract Public Hearing was called to order by Commissioner Pat Caveney at 6:45 pm October 16, 2012 at the West Danby Fire Station.

Pat reviewed the requirements of the Public Hearing. The Brooktondale Contract Public Hearing notice was posted on the Town of Danby website, the bulletin board, and published in the Danby Area News. The legal notice was also published in the Ithaca Journal with an Affidavit of Publication.

Copies of the proposed contract were available to the public, prior to and at this Public Hearing. The contract is a renewal of an existing contract with the Brooktondale Fire District for fire, rescue, and emergency medical protection for a portion of the Town of Danby in an area readily accessible from the fire station of Brooktondale and deemed desirable in the public interest due to the terrain and accessibility from the fire station of Danby Volunteer Fire Co. The contract is for four (4) years with a 2% increase per year, and has been approved by the Brooktondale Fire District.

The public was asked for comments. There were no comments.

Commissioner Westmiller made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Bowles, to adopt a resolution to approve the contract at tonight's regular meeting. Motion carried with all in favor.

The Budget Hearing adjourned at 7:00 pm.
