MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

December 10, 2013

The regular meeting of the Danby Fire District was called to order by Commissioner Westmiller at 7:30 pm on December 10, 2013 at the Danby Fire Station.

MINUTES:

Commissioner Westmiller moved to approve the Nov. 12, 2013 minutes. Motion seconded by Commissioner Halton and carried with all in favor.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

- Pete Amos of 4-Guys requested the 5% retainer be paid on Dec. 15th after the truck training scheduled for that day, leaving approximately 6 hours of training to be completed in January. Commissioner Halton moved to approve the request for early payment. Motion seconded by Commissioner Oltz. Discussion followed with the Chiefs confident that the remaining training would be completed. Motion carried with all in favor;
- The PERMA bill for 2014 Worker's Compensation was received. This will be held until January for payment from the 2014 budget;
- Moore Medical was overpaid by \$543.91 and the amount will be refunded;
- Another invoice was sent to Chief Wendt for \$20 for his DOT card obtained from Occustar at the time of our physicals;
- A check for \$325.00 was received from West Danby Fire Company for re-payment of additional legal fees incurred by the fire company and paid by the District;
- A wire transfer of \$453,171.20 (\$453.124 + 1 day of interest) was received from The Bank of Greene County for the truck bond;
- Secretary Treasurer Bowles met with Lesley Horner from CDLM, our auditor's office, regarding questions on QuickBooks;

Commissioner Halton moved to approve the treasurer's report and to pay Abstract 12 claims 452-479 in the amount of \$12988.79. Motion seconded by Commissioner Westmiller and carried with all in favor;

Commissioner Westmiller moved to pay all bills received by December 31, 2013 pertaining to 2013 expenses with the Abstract to be presented at the January meeting. Commissioner Halton seconded the motion and motion carried with all in favor.

Commissioner Oltz moved to approve a resolution to transfer a total of \$7,522 from A3410.4.514 Medical and A3410.4.503 Fire Training to A3410.4.506 (\$6,236) Danby Buildings and Grounds and to A3410.4.507 (\$1,286) West Danby Buildings and Grounds; and to transfer \$808 from A3410.4.504 Commissioner Training to A3410.2 (\$689) Danby Equipment and to A3410.4.516 (\$119) Publications. Motion seconded by Commissioner Bowles and a roll call vote was taken with all in favor.

DVFC: A written report was received for November.

DEF is required for the new pumpers for their exhaust systems. Cost is approximately \$12 for 2 ½ gal. and the Chiefs are looking at the usage required.

Station usage to recognize Frank Proto's dedication to our community as a Tompkins County Legislator since 1985 was requested for Dec. 27th at 4:30. Also Sandy Williams requested station usage on Dec. 22nd for a birthday party.

Terry Monroe requested station usage on Dec. 25th for a Christmas Party and the West Danby Community Association requested use of the station on Jan. 29th or 26th.
