CHIEF'S REPORTS:

WDFC:

- No written report August was received.
- Firefighter Nigel Dyson-Hudson requested permission to attend and out of county training course, Land Navigation training on October 12th and 13th in Oriskany New York. The training is free. He is not seeking reimbursement for mileage or meals.
- Chief Wendt reported new EMS vehicle is at Admiral Specialty Vehicles being worked on. Brief discussion held on sale of current 1442.
- Brief discussion held on status of specs for new brush truck.
- Brief discussion on firefighter medical exams
- Brief discussion held on house signs

Commissioner Westmiller moved to approve out of county training request from Firefighter Dyson-Hudson. Motion seconded by Commissioner Kokkelenberg. 5 yes. Carried 5-0.

DVFC:

- Written report for August was received
- 1 new members accepted pending District approval: Molly Lobel

- Chief Gaden has contacted electrician Dick Westbrook in regard to what amperage we have for the new outdoor sign. Brief discussion held on nightlights in new truck bay.
- 421 was State inspected and making arrangements to have 401 and 441 State inspected this month
- Vest tanks are in and Chief Gaden and Treasurer Bowles met with the Forest Ranger. NY State will be forwarding grant money to the District.

Commissioner Westmiller moved to accept Molly Lobel as a new member pending arson/sexual offender check and physical. Commissioner Faehndrich seconded. 5 yes 0 no 0 abstain. Carried 5-0.

COMMITTEES:

PURCHASING:

- Chief Gaden reported turnout gear has been received. Has not received boots.
- Chief Wendt reported he has received the new Hurst tool pump. Discussion held on T&R Rescue replacing this new tool with the Hurst tool pump originally ordered but still not in production.

BUILDINGS/GROUNDS:

- Commission Anderson gave an update on outdoor sign. Lengthy discussion held on pending decisions i.e. amber vs red on gray scale. Let the record show Commissioner Kokkelenberg is concerned color blind individuals not being able to see the sign because of these color choices. Discussion held on notifying Community Council and obtaining a memorandum of understanding from the Town. Discussion held on sign administrator and policy for notices placed on outdoor sign. Commissioner Faehndrich will draft a policy and Secretary Gaden will be the administrator.
- Chief Wendt discussed internet service through Verizon. He had a representative come to the station and service was obtained. Commissioner Faehndrich will review the contract received from Verizon and report next month. Chief Wendt has ordered 3 antennas as two can be used with the jet packs for the mobile data terminals.
- Chief Wendt reported a committee is meeting this week to prioritize the list he submitted last night in regards to repairs needed at West Danby Station.
- Commissioner Freedman has met with one company regarding pest control at both stations. He will get 2 more quotes.

GRANTS:

- Commissioner Anderson reported she and Commissioner Kokkelenberg have been in contact with Assemblywoman Barbara Lifton on the possibility of a grant. Lengthy discussion held.
- Commissioner Anderson gave an update on status of grant for SCBA packs or new compressor. Discussion held, decided to seek SCBA packs under this grant.

INSURANCE: No report

TRUCKS:

- Commissioner Kokkelenberg inquired about the cleaning of the undercarriages of 1401 and 401. Chief Gaden said they are still searching for a company to do this.
- Chief Gaden reported Admiral Specialty Vehicles will be building brackets to help keep equipment in place
- Chief Wendt will look into purchasing tires and primer for 1421

TOWN BOARD:

• Commissioner Freedman reported he has discussed a memorandum of understanding with Town Representatives for postings on the new outdoor sign at the fire station. Once we receive it we will forward it to the District's attorney for review

RECORDS:

• Received no record of arson or sex offender conviction on new member Dengel

POLICY:

• Commissioner Anderson reported the committee have the pending policies and they will be reviewing them and the current policies. The committee hopes to submit and new policies or amendments to current policies in November.

MEMBERSHIP/TRAINING:

Chief Gaden reported the Fire Companies have hired Meridan Fire Training Solutions to do 4 more classes.

LONG RANGE PLAN: No report

BUDGET:

- Commissioner Kokkelenberg advised the Chiefs the amount for dry hydrants was doubled to \$6,000.00 in the proposed 2017 budget. Chief Gaden is working with members of the Pirates Club to hopefully locate a dry hydrant on the Club's property on Fisher Settlement Road.
- Discussion held on the cost of a bus to shuttle residents of West Danby to Danby for voting in the Commissioner election on December 13, 2016. Commissioner Kokkelenberg stated the cost would be \$500.00 for continuous shuttling by Swartout Coaches, Inc. from 5 to 9.

Commissioner Kokkelenberg made a motion to pay Swartout Coaches, Inc. the amount of \$500.00 for bus shuttle service for Commissioner Election on December 13, 2016. Commissioner Faehndrich seconded. 4 yes 1 no. Carried 4-1.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Chief Gaden reported on status of new tanker 421.
- Brief discussion on maintenance of West Danby's AED Defibrilator
- Lengthy discussion on participating through the Town of Danby in the Solar Power project.

Commissioner Faehndrich made a motion the Fire District give verbal agreement, in principal to the Town of Danby for the solar project, that we are interested in participating, provided we have a satisfactory agreement between the Town and Fire District and any and all agreements are approved by the Fire Districts' attorney. Commissioner Freedman seconded. 4 yes 1 abstain. Carried 4-1.

• Chief Gaden submitted a proposal for purchasing 2 new trucks to replace Danby's brush truck (441) and utility vehicle (442). Lengthy discussion followed.

Commissioner Westmiller moved to adopt Resolution 2016-09-13.2 to move \$96,000.00 from Reserves Equipment New Capital Reserve Account to the District's General Operating Account for continued Fire District Operations for acquisition of a brush vehicle (Ford F350) and utility vehicle (Ford F250) with attendant equipment; Commissioner Kokkelenberg seconded the motion.
